Bobby's Cowboy Cookies



2c quick cooking oatmeal	2c flour
1c butter	1 tsp soda
1c brown sugar	1 tsp salt
1c granulated sugar	2 T milk
2 beaten eggs	2 tsp vanilla
1 12oz pkg. chocolate chips	

Mix butter, brown sugar, and granulated sugar. Add eggs. Add flour, soda, milk, and remaining ingredients. Preheat oven to 325°. Drop cookies on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake for 8-10 min.
